WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES AFTER CLOSING DATE/TIME

A waiting list will be kept until Tuesday, April 28, 2015, to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the waiting list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the waiting list closing date will receive a full refund.

ENTRY INFORMATION

E-mail confirmations will be sent to those providing a legible e-mail address on their entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by US Mail prior to the issuance of the judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

- **Online entries will be accepted through Zooza.com**
- Faxed entries will not be accepted. ***Credit cards may only be used as payment through Zooza.com.***
- All mailed entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms (attached), one dog per entry form.
- Photocopied entries without the AKC agreement attached are **NOT** acceptable.
- Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are **NOT** acceptable and will not be entered in the trial (AKC Rule Ch. 14, Sec. 4).
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS and DHL.
- Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. **Mail requiring signatures will be returned to sender.**
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than ten entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.
- Please make checks out to **American Belgian Malinois Club (ABMC)**.
- A returned check charge of \$12.00 will be leveled.
- Move-ups (prior to trials) will be accepted until **April 28, 2015 at 5 p.m.**
- Day to day move ups will be accepted, and must be given to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site not later than the day preceding the event.

Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award

Qualifications for Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award:

Dogs must participate and earn points in at least three of the following five venues:

Agility, Conformation (Regular and Sweepstakes), Obedience /Rally (Regular and Optional Titling classes only), Herding & Tracking

A dog may be entered in more than three venues. The single highest point value earned in each venue will be used in tabulating the points earned for that venue. The dog with the highest combined total score for all venues will be awarded Most Versatile Belgian Malinois. Reserve Most Versatile Malinois will be awarded to the second place finisher. Membership in the ABMC is not required. However, the dog being entered must be a Belgian Malinois. For further information, point scale and entry form-visit the specialty website. The MVBMA chair will track the results based on the Show/Trial Secretary information and points for each dog entered will be posted daily. The winner will be announced at the Cinco De Malinois Farewell Party on Saturday night. The winner of the award need not be present to win.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. This change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new check box at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate if their dog needs to be measured. If your dog does need to be measured, please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility trials. All classes will take place outdoors on grass. Ring size will be 100' x 100'.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, AND LIABILITY

- **By entering this trial**, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The American Belgian Malinois Club., and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- **All dogs** must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.
- **Exhibitors** are expected to clean up after their dogs.
- **Crates** may be left overnight; however, the American Belgian Malinois Club and Scenic Park Athletic Complex will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

TRIAL SITE

- **Trial Site** will be available after 7:00 a.m. Tuesday and Wednesday. This trial will be held outdoors on grass. Bring chairs, crates, and clean up tools.
- Dogs must be removed from the trial site upon completion of the trial.

FOOD

- Concessions will be available on site, and some fast food restaurants are within a mile of the trial site.

REFUNDS

- **Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete.** Entry fees less \$6.00 administrative fee will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.
- **No refunds** will be given in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- ABMC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

RINGSIDE

- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their classes if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
