Best of Breed

Awards of Merit: The Judge may, at his/her discretion, recall in to the ring approximately 10% of all dogs eligible for Best of Breed Competition to be awarded the American Belgian Malinois Club Award of Merit. These awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans Class – Classes for dogs and bitches; 7 years and over.

Veterans Note: 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG

Brace - Class for two dogs, with at least one common owner, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers.

Stud Dog - Class for Dogs with at least two progeny, with judging based solely on the merits of the get. Stud dog to be examined for disqualifying faults only.

Brood Bitch - Class for Bitches with at least two progeny, with judging based solely on the merits of the get. Brood bitch to be examined for disqualifying faults only

Generations -Each entry will consist of three dogs from three consecutive generations. The Grandsire or Granddam is actually the primary dog/bitch entered on the entry form. The grandsire and/or granddam may be neutered or spayed unless they are representing another generation entry as a sire and/or dam or get. The dogs comprising a Generations Entry must be named at the time the entry is made and must be entered in another class. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Generations Class must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" if more than one Generations Class is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Generations Class must be so designated "Generations No. 1," "Generations No. 2." Please submit Generations entries together if possible.

For Stud Dog, Brood Bitch- and Generations - All handlers must wear armbands

NATIONAL RESERVE POINTS

At the National Specialty, the dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be Awarded the three-point major, provided the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five point major in the region in which the event is held.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Handlers or Agents may handle in sweepstakes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

6-9 mos Puppy

9-12 mos Puppy

12-18 mos

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and may be spayed or neutered. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Handlers or Agents may handle in sweepstakes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- 7-9 Years
- 9-11 Years
- 11-13 Years
- 13 Years & Over

WORKING SWEEPSTAKES

Working sweepstakes honors Belgian Malinois that compete in performance, companion and working events.

To Qualify to enter Working Sweepstakes at an ABMC National Specialty Show, the dog must have earned, at a minimum, an AKC Novice level title in at least one of the following venues: Obedience (CD), Rally (RN), Tracking (TD/TDU), Herding (HSAC HSAD, HSAS, HSBC, HSBDB HSBS, HSCC, HSCD, HSCS), Agility (NA, NAJ, NAP, NPJ, NF NFP) and/or Scent Work (SCN, SIN, SEN, SBN, SHDN). These are the same venues as for the Most Versatile Malinois Award. Working sweepstakes entrants **need not be entered** in any regular conformation class at the National Specialty. Champions of record may compete but a championship is not required. Spayed or neutered bitches are eligible to compete

The following classes will be provided:

- Working Dog
- Working Bitch

MONETARY PRIZES FOR ALL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Undistributed funds revert to the Club.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that

year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class o compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233–9767.

BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

Jump Height in descending order for Obedience & Rally

A qualifying score is required for all prizes in Obedience & Rally. “Dog” means either sex. A dark green ribbon will be given to each entry receiving a qualifying score in the Regular Classes.

Transfers (formerly Move-ups)

After a dog earns a title, a transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner’s records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

For a written request regarding a transfer for an ineligible dog and handler team from the “A” class to the “B” class at the same level, please refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16b

4 - 6 MONTHS BEGINNER PUPPY (National Only)

Dog & Bitches will be judged together

One combined class will be offered for dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. There will be a selection of Best of Breed 4 & Under 6 Months puppy, and Best of Opposite Sex.

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for all entries.

A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian’s protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.

PARADE OF HONOR & RESCUE

All Malinois are eligible to enter the Parade. Dogs need not be entered in any other class to participate, but the entry form must have "Parade" on it. Please include a resume about the dog

with the entry. This will be read during the Parade. Each participant will receive a commemorative rosette. Resumes will not be accepted at the show. To enter please complete the form on Page 15.

She found the hot, pliable steel was an incredible medium that could be bent, hammered and shaped any way she liked. After 16 years of shoeing, she decided it was time to switch directions and head into the art world. Line sculpture is a signature style for Esther. She also works in clay and bronze. Each year she sculpts several cast sculptures along with her hand-created steel and bronze sculptures. Esther's work is on display at the Newby Gallery in Tubac, Arizona. After Esther came to Bandera County, Texas from her up-state New York childhood home, her style of life-sized metal sculpture and artwork became an instant and long-running success story. Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award (MVBMA) and Reserve Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award (RMVBMA) are given to the Belgian Malinois at the National Specialty that excels and qualifies in at least three different venues. a. Dogs must earn points (i.e., qualify) in at least three of the following six venues: agility, conformation, herding, obedience, rally and scent work. If tracking is offered, it becomes the seventh venue that dogs may enter to obtain their three venues. Dogs do not have to enter all venues, but MUST qualify and earn points in at least three different venues to qualify for MVBMA or RMVBMA. If no dog qualifies in at least three venues, no MVBMA or RMVBMA will be presented. Membership in the ABMC is not required. The single highest point value earned in each venue will be used in tabulating the points earned for that venue. Example: Dog A wins the Excellent A Regular Standard Agility class (5 points) and Double Q's in Excellent Regular Standard and Regular JWW (7 points). Dog A will be awarded 7 points not 12. The dogs receiving the MVBMA or RMVBMA must be AKC registered Belgian Malinois."

Tie-Breaking Criteria:

In the event of a tie, the winner will be the dog participating and earning points in the most numbers of venues. For example, in a tie, the dog that had earned points in all five venues would win over a dog that earned points in only three venues. If a tie still exists, all point values earned in each venue would be combined and totaled for each dog with the highest total score being the winning dog. For example, a dog that had earned a High in Trial in Obedience by winning the Novice B class would count 9 points for High in Trial plus 4 points for winning Novice B plus 3 points for qualifying in Novice B. In the event the dogs were still tied after this tally, ABMC would recognize that an absolutely tie occurred and dual awards would be given.

CONFORMATION GROOMING RESERVATION

At our 2021 National Specialty in Michigan, there was no grooming and no blow-dryers allowed anywhere - and we all survived! In 2022 we have been able to secure some limited bathing and grooming opportunities on Thursday May 5, and Friday May 6 in Barn Q after the completion of each day's Scent Work trial. Note: No grooming is permitted in the Arena at any time. No exceptions.

Reserved grooming stall: Bathing and grooming opportunities are by reservation only, starting at 5:30 pm each evening. You will have access to hot and cold water, and use of a state-of-the-art 12' x 14' horse stall with wall-to-wall anti-fatigue matting and a built-in overhead fan for the evening where you can set up your grooming table and blow dryer. You will have access to a 20-amp electrical circuit. Please bring your own extension cord as the outlet is on the outside of the stall. If your grooming tables do not have rubber caps on the legs and your tables cut into the new floor matting, you will be responsible for the cost of repairs to the surface. Please bring a mat to put under your tables if you are not sure.

(Regarding the 20-amp electrical circuits. If you are sharing space two dryers can usually be run together at 20 amps, but both dryers should not be started at the same time, since their simultaneous initial (start-up) draw would probably exceed 20 amps. Please check your dryers running amperage and make sure you and your partner will be able to run your dryers together without exceeding 20 amps. WEC will provide one free reset per blown circuit. NOTE: there will be a \$30 charge for subsequent resetting of the same circuit thereafter.)

The barn will be closed at 11 PM at which time you must remove your equipment each evening. No dogs in the Barn overnight.

Cost of one stall for grooming is \$25 per evening.
