DIRECTIONS TO MINTZER FARM

From 75 exit 314 (North or South)

Go East on CR 48 approx. 5 miles - CR 561 will be on the North. CR 561 is a dead end in ½ mile, tree-lined, paved road dead ends at the gate of Mintzer farm.

From SR 50 (East or West)

At intersection of US Hwy 301, travel North approx. 10 miles to intersection at CR 48 in Bushnell. Travel East on CR 48. CR 561 is a dead end in ½ mile, tree-lined, paved road dead ends at the gate of Mintzer farm.

From Turnpike

Take exit 285 (Leesburg/Clermont) toward US-27/FL-19. Turn right onto US-27N. Turn left on Bridges Rd., becomes Austin Merritt Rd, then Youth Camp Rd., then County Road 702. Take a slight left onto FL-48W/CR 48. Turn right onto CR 561. CR 561 is a dead end in ½ mile, tree-lined, paved road dead ends at the gate of Mintzer farm.
